To be fair, there instances in Dynamics of Faith where Tillich, whether he realizes it or not, creates the possibility for such a reading, namely his insistence that faith is always an act of courage and risk from within the conditions of existence (19-20ff.). Nevertheless, Tillich's Neoplatonic proclivities and his reliance upon the linear trajectory outlined above cannot be overlooked.

This might superficially appear similar to the wholly orthodox Christian doctrine of the possibility of theosis (divinization) for the human being, but a crucial departure from orthodoxy is apparent in that Tillich speaks of human nature as effectively already divinized by virtue of an ontological connection to the ground of Being rather than requiring radical regeneration through the Holy Spirit.
